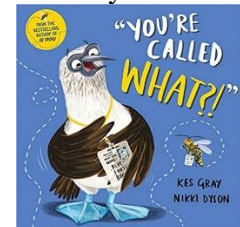

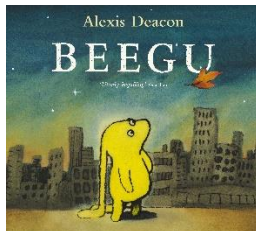
Here is a list of the 25 books that the staff at Ark Academy think are important reads for Year 1 students.

We challenge you to read as many as you can, with your child, over the year!

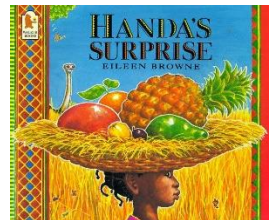
